NUMEROUS COUNTY COMMISSION ADVISORY BOARD POSITIONS ARE OPEN

The Citrus County Commission relies on citizen volunteers who want to serve their community by sitting on boards that advise the commission. The commission is currently accepting applications for vacancies current or about to come open on numerous volunteer advisory boards.

- The Aviation Advisory Board has one position open for a Regular Member. The member must reside in District 3 (north central Citrus). The term is for two years.
- The Fire Code Appeals Board has two positions open for Regular Members. They are required to complete a financial disclosure form and the term is for three years.
- The Historical Resources Advisory Board has one position open for an Alternate Member. The term is for two years.
- The Construction Licensing and Appeals Board has one position open. The member can not be an electrical, mechanical, plumbing building or residential contractor unless he/she holds more than one license. Members are required to file a financial disclosure form. The term is for three years.
- The Code Review and Appeals Board has one position open for a Regular Member. The member must have knowledge and experience in the building trades and will be required to file a financial disclosure form. The term is for four years.
- The Planning Development and Review Board has five positions open. Three are for Regular Members and two are for Alternate Members. The Regular Member positions require that one of the applicants reside in District 1 (northwest Citrus), one in District 2 (southwest Citrus) and one in District 4 (southeast Citrus). Members are required to complete a financial disclosure form. The terms are for three years.
- The Special Library District Advisory Board has five positions open for Regular Members. The terms are for two years.
- The Transportation Disadvantaged Coordinating Board has five positions open: one for an economically disadvantaged person; one for a disabled

citizen; one for a military veteran; one for a local medical community representative; one for an elderly resident who must be over 60 years of age; and one for a person recognized by the Florida Association for Community Action as representing the economically disadvantaged in the county. The terms are for three years.

- The Water and Wastewater Authority has one position open for an Alternate Member. Members are required to complete a financial disclosure forms. The term is for one year.
- The Tourism Development Council has three openings: one for a person who demonstrates interest in tourism development and two positions for owner/operators of tourism accommodations.
- The Well Florida Council has one position open for a Purchaser, Consumer or Provider of Health Care Services who lives or works in Citrus County. The Council meets every quarter from 2 p.m. to 5 p.m. in Gainesville and members are reimbursed for mileage at the state rate. The term is for two years.
